

Toaster Pastry Library Card Holder / Stuffed Toy

You Will Need:

- Crochet hook (2-3 sizes smaller than suggested on yarn label for nice, tight stitches.)
- Yarn – light worsted weight – light brown, color of your choice for the icing
- Safety buttons, beads, or embroidery floss to make eyes (Stitch markers or scrap piece of yarn
- Yarn and/or embroidery needle
- Poly-fil or other type of stuffing for toy
- Small button for card holder.



Abbreviations

- Ch – Chain Stitch
- Sc – Single Crochet
- St/Sts – Stitch/Stitches
- Slst – Slip Stitch
- Inc (Increase) – 2 Sc into 1 St
- Dec (Decrease) – 1 Sc across 2 Sts
- ** – Marks a group of stitches to be repeated until the round is completed

Finished Size

Card holder will be 2" x 3.5".

Stuffed toy will depend on thickness of yarn and hook size used

Card Holder

Start with light brown

Ch 9

R1: inc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 6 chs, 4 sc in last ch, then working down other side of ch, sc in next 6 ch, inc in last ch. (20)

R2 - R18: sc around. (20)

Fasten off.

Icing

With color of choice.

Ch 9

R1: sc in 2nd chain from hook, sc in next 7 ch.

R2 – 15: ch1 and turn. Sc across (8)

Fasten off.

* Optional: add "sprinkles" using embroidery floss or other colors of yarn.

* Add eyes between rows and embroider a smile.

* Weave in ends.

* Add keychain (optional)

Stuffed toy

Using tail of beige yarn, blanket stitch across opening at top. Finish off and weave in ends.
